The Cranberry Isles Internet Broadband Committee, a working group set up in 2016 to work on solutions for providing broadband internet service to the Town, will hold a public informational forum to discuss the warrant article (Article #26) related to broadband internet at the 2017 Annual Town Meeting. Information on the capital costs and operational budget, and an outline of a partnership agreement with Axiom Technologies, an internet service provider (ISP), will be presented by members of the committee. Committee members and representatives from Axiom will be on hand to answer questions from Cranberry Isles residents about the proposed buildout of a fiber network for Great Cranberry, Islesford, and Sutton Island.
